

Others recognize all that Utah has to offer and move here










IS IT POSSIBLE TO STOP UTAH'S GROWTH?

 - Decreasing birth rate
 - Lower life expectancy
 - Neither is enough to stop growth
- New residents
 - Drawn to strong economy
 - Enjoy Utah's natural beauty and culture
 - Find the cost of living in Utah to be affordable
 - Slowing the economy is not wise
 - desirable Limiting Utah's beauty or changing the culture is not
 - Raising the cost of living hurts existing residents






