## Moderate Income Housing Plan Penalties

### 10-9a-408 & 17-27a-408

Transportation Fund of 2005 including the Transit Transportation Investment Fund

#### **SB 174**

Starting in 2024, if NOT compliant then \$250 per day to the Olene Walker Fund

Increases to \$500 per day starting in 2025

# Other Significant Housing Affordability Developments Cont.

#### HOUSING APPROPRIATIONS\*

- \$75+ Million Homeless Services, Deeply Affordable Housing and Attainable Housing Grants
- \$10 million Utah Housing Preservation Fund
- \$7 million Box Elder Crisis Shelter and Transitional Housing
- \$5 million Shared Equity Revolving Loan Fund
- \$4 million Affordable Housing Technical Assistance
- \$2.75 million Rural Single-Family Home Land Revolving Loan Program
- \$1.5 Million Home Repair Programs
- \$500,000 Veterans First-time Homebuyer Program
- \$600,000 Section 8 Landlord Incentive
