
## Average Persons per Dwelling




## Increase in Persons per Dwelling

2022 Census shows average of 3.77 people per dwelling unit in Lehi

City survey of 165 existing ADUs shows majority (75%+) are rented to 2 or more people

2+ people is greater than the 1.5 people used in the infrastructure calculations (meaning impacts will be greater than what infrastructure calculations show)

## Parking Impacts

HB 82 restricts City off-street parking to 1 stall per ADU

City's ADU survey shows 64% of renters have 2 or more cars


Additional cars will end up parked on the street

City code prohibits parking on public streets from November 1 to March 30, between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.

On street parking is also prohibited during or within 24 hours after a snowstorm

Snowplows are large and difficult to maneuver around obstacles
